Appointed Chief Compliance Officer in 2012, Petter Törnquist was put in charge of coordinating and developing Saab's work within business ethics. He now heads the Group Function Ethics and Compliance, which is a center of competence for business ethics with a particular focus on anti-bribery and corruption, whistleblowing and investigations.

Ethics and Compliance manages and coordinates the development of Saab's Code of Conduct, issues and develops relevant policies, procedures and tools, conducts and sets requirements for training and provides advice to the entire Saab group. The function also organizes the work of the Ethics and Compliance Board, manages Saab's whistleblowing system, and conducts and supervises investigations. Today Saab's ethics and compliance program is rated in the top tier of the industry.

Petter first joined Saab in 2008 as legal counsel. Before joining Saab, Petter was a senior associate in the Stockholm office of Setterwalls law firm where he started in 1999 specializing in dispute resolution, competition law and M&A practice. He acted for private and public companies in both arbitration and court proceedings and represented clients in connection with cartel investigations, merger filings and compliance programs. He advised on a vast variety of transactions including mergers and acquisitions, joint ventures and corporate restructurings. In 2001 he was seconded to the London office of the international law firm K&L Gates (formerly Nicholson Graham & Jones).

He has served as assistant judge at Södra Roslags District Court in Stockhlom and started his professional career in 1997 as a trainee at the Swedish law firm Vinge.
